

### **Thames Court Pub**

This river side pub is a great lunch spot for day trips. With a large outdoor beer garden and good food, this pub can facilitate for the whole family. **CAN GET BUSY ON SUNNY DAYS**

As you leave the marina turn right heading upstream following the Desborough Island loop. As you approach the Shepperton lock you can either portage around the lock or if the lock keeper is there he may allow you to paddle through.

100yds upstream of the lock there is a patch of grass just outside the pub, it's easy to get out of your boat and there is plenty of space to pull the boats out of the water.

### **The Old Crown Pub**

As you leave the marina turn right heading upstream following the Desborough Island route. As you approach Shepperton lock keep left following the river round to the left. Look right and you will see the weir. Keep to the left bank until you begin to head down a small channel, approaching a small boat yard. The river forks around a small island, keep right. At the top of this island look left and you will see a small beer garden and boat jetty. Exit your boat at the jetty and pull the boat up out of the water. Good pub food, good beer.

### **The Red Lion Pub**

As you leave the marina turn right heading upstream following the Desborough Island route. As you approach the island go round to the right. As you paddle up to the first major bend in the river you should spot a small island on the right hand bank. You should also be able to see a small boat jetty and beer garden find a safe spot to jump out and secure the boats. The pub is just the other side of the road, be careful as the road can be busy! Good space and seating by the river, also good space and plenty of tables in the pub itself. Great food and drinks.

### **The Weir Pub**

As you leave the marina turn left heading downstream. Keep to the right hand side, after approximately 1km you will see Sunbury Weir on the left (**Be careful and stay away from the weir**) Keep right and look right, you should be able to spot the pub. There is a jetty and patch of grass just outside the pub that you can use to climb out of your boat. Pull the boat up and out of the water. Good selection of Ale, Good traditional pub grub.

### **The Angles Pub**

This is the closest pub. Exit the marina and turn left paddle up about 350 Meters. On the right hand bank you will see a car park and the pub right on the waters edge. You can climb out here and pull the boats out of the water. Good food and selection of drinks.
